**GOAL 1:** By September 1, 2013, increase student achievement by mastering grade level standards in all content areas and ensure Pre-K to high school readiness as measured by an API Score of 800 or above at each site.

**GOAL 2:** By June 30, 2013, attract, develop and retain quality teachers, administrators and staff by 90% as measured by exit interview data, staff surveys and Board action.

**GOAL 3:** By June 30, 2013, increase parent involvement at each site by 60% as measured by attendance, surveys, parent service hours, School Site Council and DELAC participation.

**GOAL 4:** By June 30, 2013, increase school safety by 80% as measured by SWIS data, student incident reports, Healthy Kid surveys, school climate surveys and parent/community perception surveys.

**GOAL 5:** By June 30, 2013, exit RSIP as measured by Consent Decree.

**GOAL 6:** By June 30, 2013, ensure fiscal solvency by increasing the district's revenues as measured by 1% increase in reserves.
